

Rolleston Quarry

Community Liaison Group Meeting

Held at the Rolleston Quarry - Wards Road

Thursday 27 November 2014

Meeting commenced at 7:30 pm.

Minutes from the previous meeting were confirmed as true and correct.

The pole for the flag light had been installed and the lighthouse would be installed when it was available.

Simon had confirmed his resignation from the CLG and so the group would be looking for another member of the community to join.

Clayton was nominated and then unanimously elected as chair for the CLG.

Traffic numbers were discussed and clarified that every truck load equated to two traffic movements.

ECan had received a complaint regarding dust from the quarry. The data from the dust monitor showed full compliance with the consent conditions. It was also noted that some paddocks on the property were being worked / ploughed on the same day and this was creating noticeable dust.

ECan and SDC had received complaints regarding weed control around the quarry. The land opposite the quarry on Wards Rd had since had the thistles sprayed.

Water quality monitoring would be undertaken before cleanfilling commenced.

The concrete plant had been constructed and was expected to be operational by the end of the year.

It was noted that some vehicles were not complying with the temporary 50 km/h speed restriction on Wards Rd. Weighbridge staff would ensure the message was passed on to all vehicles leaving the quarry.

It was proposed that the next meeting would be held on site at the Rolleston Quarry on Wards Rd on February 26th at 7:30 pm.
