Meeting commenced at 7:35 pm.

Minutes from the previous meeting were confirmed as true and correct.

The consent variation decision had been made.

The CLG was informed that current traffic numbers still complied with the current consent.

With regard to encouraging trucks not to use Kerrs Road, it was confirmed that the updated Driver Code of Conduct had been distributed to all truck drivers and a sign had been installed near the exit to the quarry. The weighbridge operator also informed drivers of the requirements.

Noise monitoring for the concrete plant would be undertaken on an occasion when the concrete plant started production early in the morning to minimise any noise interference from other sources. There had been no early starts as yet.

A notice had been put up at the weighbridge for a period asking drivers not to use their engine brakes if possible.

Clayton is still looking into finding another community representative for the CLG before the next meeting.

Road Metals was looking at holding at open day at the quarry in the summer for residents and families to come and have a look at the quarry and machinery.

It was proposed that the next meeting would be held on site at the Rolleston Quarry on Wards Rd on November 19th at 7:30 pm.
