

Yaldhurst Quarry – RM4

Community Liaison Group Meeting

Held at the Yaldhurst Quarry – West Coast Road

Thursday 30 July 2020

Meeting commenced at 6:07 pm.

Lindsay explained what work had been undertaken as part of the quarry extension to date. This included the extraction of nearly all the material from the 581 Buchanans Rd block and some rehabilitation in this area. The next six months would be more of the same with extraction dependant on market demand.

Dust data for the year was shared with the group and was currently being sent through to ECan on a monthly basis. This information was also available on the Road Metals website.

The CCC and ECan had not received any complaints or noticed any issues with the RM4 extension.

The residents had no specific complaints but had noticed some noise in the general area over the lockdown period.

It was confirmed for the residents that the area referred to as 'the fingers', would be rehabilitated back to original ground level as per request from the residents during the consenting process.

It was proposed that the next meeting would be held on site at the Yaldhurst Quarry on 28 January 2021 at 6pm.
