

Rolleston Quarry

Community Liaison Group Meeting

Held at the Rolleston Quarry - Wards Road

Thursday 13th March 2025

Present: John Roux, Mark Alexander, Lindsay Forbes (Road Metals), Murray Francis (Road Metals)

Apologies: Jonny Francis (Road Metals), Tess Hindle-Daniels (ECan)

Meeting commenced at 4:15 pm.

Minutes from the previous meeting were confirmed as true and correct and there were no matters arising.

John Roux said he had come into the Quarry regarding dust seen leaving the northern boundary and complained to office staff. John had also noticed dust on another occasion but had not reported it. It was suggested again that we shift the current Dust Monitor further west to opposite Tresillian Drive to monitor any fugitive dust on the northern boundary.

Murray mentioned that Road Metals had purchased the Lill property further along Wards Road. This property would eventually be extracted and conveyed under Sandy Knowles Road to existing processing Plant.

Mark Alexander enquired about current truck numbers and as Jonny was absent from the meeting it was suggested he would follow up when available. Lindsay mentioned that although it had been noted in the previous minutes, that applying to increase truck numbers was still a possibility. Murray also suggested that when Winstone Aggregate started producing from their proposed quarry that Road Metals truck numbers may reduce.

Murray told the group that Road Metals were successful in winning an Environmental award at the 2024 Institute of Quarrying Conference for the Solar Panels installed to provide power for the processing plant. This was a first for any Quarry in New Zealand to install at this scale.
