

## Rolleston Quarry

### Community Liaison Group Meeting

Held at the Rolleston Quarry - Wards Road

Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2026

Meeting commenced at 4:04 pm.

The traffic numbers for the past 12 months were presented to the group. The 3 month rolling average was compliant but there had been occasions where traffic numbers were above the limit.

It was confirmed that the Dust Monitor had been shifted further west and is now in line with Tresillian Drive. This monitor had also been upgraded and was now recording TPM, PM10 and PM4.

Minor changes had been made to the SDC consent for the site to enable extraction from the neighbouring property on Sandy Knolls Road (Lill block). The long term plan for the quarry operation remains the same with the processing plant and sales point remaining the same.

Current truck numbers were presented to the group and it was noted there had been exceedances, including spikes in January, linked to multiple projects occurring at the same time.

To ensure ongoing compliance, Road Metals had applied to increase allowable traffic movements from the site.

While there were no plans to increase crushing capacity, an additional conveying system was being installed to increase efficiencies and reduce on site vehicle movements.

A request was made for dust monitoring data to be presented at future meetings and this would be provided going forward.

A resolution to put the CLG into recess was considered but it was decided that there was value in the meetings and they would continue at this stage. If community members were unable to attend or there was a lack of interest, then Road Metals could provide an update via email.

There was discussion around how to get more members of the community involved in the CLG, whether this was by mail drop or at the next quarry open day.

No further issues to be discussed, meeting closed 5.06pm
